- 1) Resident of one of the following Nebraska counties: Lincoln, Custer, Dawson, Frontier, Hayes, Keith, Logan, McPherson or Perkins.
 - 2) Applicant must be a veteran of the armed forces or a member of the armed forces reserves or a member of the National Guard or who has been honorably discharged from such armed service and who intends to pursue postsecondary education.

Where can scholarship be used? Any accredited U.S. school providing postsecondary education, including technical & trade schools.

Scholarship amount? One scholarship of \$450 will be awarded for the coming school year. Scholarship recipient will be notified by mail or e-mail.
