- Test activities with your students (fall 2010)

Requirements

- You must have the time and equipment to test the prototype materials with students, including computers with high-speed internet connection, latest version of popular web browser (such as Mozilla Firefox and Internet Explorer), latest version of the Adobe Flash plug in, and the ability to upload and download files.
