


NELIGH AMERICAN LEGION SCHOLARSHIP

1. The amount of the scholarship will be \$500. for one year. Payments will be forwarded to the instate college of their choice with equal payments for the 1st and 2nd semester. The recipient must maintain a 2.5 grade point average on a 4 point scale system.
2. The student must be a relative of a veteran: Son, daughter, grandson, grand daughter or the brother/sister of a deceased veteran.
3. The selection committee will include the following: 3 members of Post 172 selected by the executive committee, but not necessarily members of that committee. The principal and guidance counselor of the Neligh-Oakdale high school shall be a NON voting member but used as advisors for the selection committee.
4. The scholarship will be awarded each spring at the awards assembly of the Neligh-Oakdale school.
5. In the event no qualified applicant is available, the scholarship will not be awarded.
6. The amount of the scholarship can be adjusted depending upon available funds, increased or decreased. It will continue as long as funds are available.
